Comprehensive Clay

Inspired by the extensive ceramics collection at the Art Gallery of Burlington, students in this workshop will create a more complex sculptural piece such as a tea pot or shoe. Hand building techniques will be demonstrated with emphasis on proper technique and attention to detail.

Comprehensive Watercolour

This workshop, inspired by the history of great watercolour painters is an introduction to painting techniques with watercolours; including even and graded washes, wet on wet and dry brush. Each technique will be demonstrated using artist quality pigments and papers. A review of primary, secondary and tertiary colours is included and an opportunity to work with frisket latex resist to experience positive and negative space. Students will develop confidence with the medium to be able to use these skills to create a final painting.

Comprehensive Drawing

Beyond basic drawing this workshop enables students to experiment with different mark making materials – pencils, charcoal and markers, exploring the unique qualities of each. Basic drawing techniques will be reviewed along with the elements of design. Students will work from a still life composition.
