## Art Workshops

#### Little Artists

This workshop, inspired by the history of great watercolour painters is an introduction to painting techniques with watercolours. Students will start with a simple colour wheel and compose an abstract painting using collage techniques to explore washes, stippling and texturing with sponges with emphasis on primary and secondary colours, pattern and line.

#### Let's Create a Print

Printmaking is the process of creating duplicate painted images from an original. This workshop offers an introduction to mono printing that produces single prints with the use of a plexi-glass plate and water soluble inks. Basic printing techniques are explored through a series of practice prints prior to creating a final print.

#### Clay – 3D Organic Shapes

The Art Gallery of Burlington has the largest collection of Canadian contemporary ceramics in the world. As an introduction to working in clay this workshop focusses on hand building construction methods including pinch pot, slab building and coil technique. The 3D sculpture is built and surface decoration is applied. Teachers are advised to supply a theme for this exercise.

#### Clay – 2D Mask Making

This workshop introduces students to basic design and construction techniques for 2D clay masks. The clay is rolled out and cut before surface texture is applied by incising, stamping and adding clay to build up the surfaces. Teachers are advised to supply a theme for this exercise.

Many of these programs are suitable workshops for Kindergarten classes!
