Fibre Arts – Dreamcatchers

Create an aboriginal dream catcher using traditional materials - a perennial favorite. After a review of design elements such as colour, size and texture, students will be challenged to use their math skills in binding and off-loom weaving enhancing their understanding of positive and negative space. A short history of dreamcatchers is included.

Fibre Arts - Basket Making

Take a step back in time and practise a heritage craft; the ancient art of basket weaving. This workshop explores basic weaving and interlock techniques to produce a stake and strand basket which is composed of round and flat reeds. Students will use natural and dyed reeds to produce a variety of colour and weave effects. The goal is for each student to be able to complete one article in class.

Clay – Animated Sculptures

This workshop introduces students to the malleability of clay using hand building techniques with emphasis on proper technique and attention to detail. Students will gain an understanding of proper proportions and figure construction to produce a free standing figure. Finished pieces will be bisque fired and can be picked up two weeks after the workshop.
