As a Fibre Artist, Mita has developed an amazing body of work with her “surface weaving” technique. She has been very successful in entering her work into numerous shows in the past year. She has just created her website which casts a glimpse into her technique and process. Mita shows her patience and mastery of her work not only in the final product of her piece but also in the process having taken her over 80 to 100 hours to create them.

About My Talk

I will share current inspirations and work interpreting silhouettes, shadows, and reflections – the graceful, organic abstractions created by the interplay of light and environment. I will also discuss the creative process and explain my own technique of “surface weaving”. This combination of stitch, weaving, and free-motion quilting creates richly textured surfaces with myriad color variations and interactions.
