Course Outline:

Bring your own photos to class and let your creativity and imagination transform them into unique paintings. We will work from personal as well as found imagery, and learn how to paint either a convincing or fantastical narrative space – the choice will be yours. The instructor will help broaden your understanding of the principals of paint handling, colour theory, tonality, composition, perspective, human anatomy and proper use of materials. Students may work in oil or acrylic paint. This is a course for all levels, and a sense of adventure is encouraged.

Course Materials:

- Your photos.
- Prepared canvas board, stretched canvas or wooden support panels as a painting surface (must have at least 3 layers of Gesso).
- Variety of oil (or acrylic) colours, including all primary colours.
- Linseed oil or Galkyd as a painting medium for oil paints (no turpentine please) □ Small containers for dipping medium.
- A paper or wooden palette for paint mixing.
- Variety of brushes, in different sizes and shapes.
- Rags and paper towels for clean up.
- Pencil and ruler.
- Small sketch pad.

***Please note that paintings must be taken home at the end of each class.**
