### Course Outline:

Hit & Miss is a design technique for using up bits and pieces of either new or reclaimed material in an organized, yet randomized fashion. In the tradition of this Canadian art-craft, each of the cast-off strips of wool tells a story from earlier projects. During this 4-week session, participants will make a 8" x 8" trivet, and learn the finishing technique of "whipping". Class is suitable for beginners and advanced rug hookers alike.

### Course Materials:

There is an additional \$25 material fee payable to the instructor at the first class for all materials. A traditional rug hook (optional) is also available for \$10.
