## Course Outline:

A great introduction for the amateur photographer who owns a DSLR/Mirrorless camera (with interchangeable lenses) and who currently uses the camera in Automatic Mode. You will understand which manual mode features to use to gain more control of the image making process.

### Weekly Sessions

Each session is a combination of in-class practice, photography theory and technical instruction on how to use their camera's Manual Mode.

Where possible, in-class exercises allow each student to practice technical aspects of their camera's Manual Mode and metering system.

Weekly homework assignments encourage students to practice the technical points presented during each class. At the beginning of each class, the homework assignment from the previous week is displayed/reviewed by the class and the Instructor.

### Student Handouts

Each session students receive an easy-to-read handout detailing all the photography theory and technical instruction presented in class. By the end of the course, all the handouts form a handy "reference document" for each student on how to use their camera in Manual Mode.
