Course Description:

Take the skills learned from Intro to Stained Glass or equivalency to produce a final 8" x 10" panel. Fabricate and take home an original design. The final pattern will consist of 16 – 20 finished pieces incorporated into the 8" x 10" panel.

Course Materials:

There is an additional material cost of **\$80.00** payable to the instructor at the first class for all required materials and access to instructor's tools to enable students to complete one 8" x 10" panel.

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Course Outline:

Class one:

Examples and samples of suitable photographic studies will be demonstrated. Students will have half hour to find images in supplied sources (or brought from home).

Photocopies will be printed and design samples and rules will be demonstrated. Students will have class time to design but may have homework.

Class two: Safety: Students will begin the class by going over safety procedures on handout provided, cut out designs in glass.

Class three:

Foil and Solder cut glass centers

Class Four:

Drop centers into background glass

Class Five:

Cutting foiling and soldering

Class six:

Cutting foiling and soldering

Class seven

Foil and solder and begin to frame panel with came

Class eight

Finish frame, wash patina and polish.
