Course Outline:

This course is designed for intermediate students, who will create a contemporary abstract painting with an optical decorative effect in which the organic form of the Lunaria plant is the focal point. Students will practice gestural brush strokes and play with pattern repetition, adding details using sgraffito techniques. Centre yourself with a creative activity to quiet your mind.

Course Materials:

Students should come to each class with the following materials:

Primed canvas 24"x 24" regular or gallery style.

Acrylic Paints: Liquitex Basic; acrylic black, Titanium White

Liquitex Gloss super heavy gel

iridescent medium Artist loft

Brushes: bristle filbert oval (#10 Simply Simmons) and 3 inch flat

scratching tool or scratching end of small brush #20/0 Royal&Langnickel

White plastic palette for mixing(tray), water container, pencil, cotton swabs, white chalk, paper towel.
